Event overview: The annual We The Peoples Film Festival is organized by the United Nations Association Westminster Branch, affiliated to the United Nations Association (UNA UK) which is the UK's leading source of independent analysis on the UN and a nationwide grassroots movement for peace, development and human rights.

The We the Peoples Film Festival is Europe's longest running film festival which has screened more than 300 films from 50 countries on human rights, development, security and peace. The festival will screen a range of features, documentaries, shorts, and host debates with industry professionals & decision makers.

In 2019, the We The Peoples Film Festival will continue to raise important issues associated with the United Nations Three Pillars of Freedom: from want, from fear and the freedom to live in dignity.

Volunteer roles & responsibilities: The event-team is responsible to plan and run **one** the screenings of the film festival during the two-week festival. Duties include: Liaising with venues and film directors, researching and booking speakers, finding sponsors, hosting & curating one of the screenings.

You will be working in teams and you will work remotely in your own time. You will meet up from time to time for face-to-face meetings with your team.
