As with the above menu awards, you can access £125 per film for programme enhancement, wraparound activity and audience development, but for this option you should apply for a Bespoke Award using the special instructions below.

The titles

- Ish (2025)
 - an award-winning new film shot in Luton, offering a strong contemporary story with a distinctive, stylistically rich perspective
- Angus, Thongs & Perfect Snogging (2008)
 - Gurinder Chadha’s cult classic was filmed in coastal areas of Brighton and Eastbourne, and provides early 2000s nostalgia for audiences
- A Clockwork Orange (1971)
 - once-banned, Kubrick’s masterpiece has connections to locations across Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire, and Hertfordshire, and will be a strong draw for audiences to experience on the big screen
